

Door To Door Segregation Awareness

Swachh Vidhyalay Awareness Program





Swachh Vidhyalay Awareness Program




This initiative is crucial as it teaches children the value of cleanliness from a young age, highlighting that maintaining cleanliness is not only a personal duty but also a collective responsibility. The program ended with a commitment to cleanliness made by both students and teachers. The principal and staff of the school reaffirmed their dedication to supporting these initiatives. The Bareilly Municipal Corporation plans to keep organizing similar events to enhance the cleanliness and health of the city, promoting collaborative efforts to turn Bareilly into a cleaner and more attractive place.











Single Use Plastic Banned Campaign











A campaign against single-use plastic was organized, during which shopkeepers were encouraged to replace plastic and single-use polythene with cloth bags. Information was provided on the harmful effects of plastic, emphasizing that plastic with less than 50 microns deteriorates after a single use, is non-biodegradable, and cannot be reused, making it detrimental to the environment and human life. Feedback was gathered from residents of the ward during the activity in this locality, some of whom pledged to stop using single-use plastic. Several individuals, including Ram, Mohan, Shiv, Rupesh, Rakesh, Mukesh, and Ankur, actively participated in the campaign and were made aware of the importance of this initiative.










Clean Toilet Campaign (Swachh Sauchalya Abhiyaan)



As per the government guidelines, the "Clean Toilet Campaign" is being conducted from November 19 to December 25, 2024. Under this initiative, on November 25, 2024, the Swachh Bharat Mission team of Bareilly Municipal Corporation organized an awareness drive at community and public toilets. Students from various schools' Swachh Sarathi Clubs actively participated in the campaign. Activities were conducted at specific locations, including the community toilet on Chaupla Road with students from Police Modern School, the community toilet near Kila Thana with students from Tilak Inter College, and the public toilet at DelapeerChauraha with students from P.C. Azad Inter College.

As part of the initiative, members of the Swachh Sarathi Clubs displayed essential information related to community toilets constructed by the Municipal Corporation, such as caretaker details, contact numbers, Google locator IDs, and available facilities, on the toilet walls. Bareilly Municipal Corporation celebrated World Toilet Day today with the inauguration of a new toilet facility under Chaupula Bridge by Honourable Mayor Dr. Umesh Gautam, in the presence of the Environmental Engineer and the ward councillor. On this occasion, a special cleanliness drive was conducted around all public toilets in the city. The Swachh Bharat Mission team undertook thorough cleaning and organized awareness campaigns at all toilet sites.









People found practicing open defecation were counselled on the health risks associated with it and encouraged to use the public toilets established by the Municipal Corporation. The public was urged to adopt toilet usage as a step towards a healthier tomorrow. This newly inaugurated toilet is equipped with modern amenities, including adequate water supply and regular maintenance, managed by Jagran Agency to ensure cleanliness.









Swachh Chath Pooja





Awareness Activities Of 14420





Capacity Building Program







They also demonstrated the functioning of the plastic pellet machine, showcasing how plastic waste is recycled into small granules that can be reused. The initiative aimed to educate children about effective waste management and the importance of recycling in promoting environmental sustainability.
















Roko Toko Abhiyaan
















Bareilly 311 App

Exposure Visit At S.T.P. Plant And Legacy Plant By IAS Trainees






As part of the comprehensive urban development initiative, 12 IAS trainees were provided with an extensive overview of the responsibilities, departments, and operations managed by Bareilly Municipal Corporation. At the Integrated Command and Control Centre (ICCC), the trainees were presented with a demonstration of surveillance activities related to city cleanliness, traffic management, and hotspot monitoring. The session included a concise briefing on related nuances and issues by Municipal Commissioner Shri Sanjeev Kumar Maurya and Additional Municipal Commissioner Shri Sunil Kumar Yadav. Subsequently, the trainees visited the Legacy Waste Plant at Bakerganj, where Environmental Engineer Shri Rajeev Kumar Rathi explained the scientific disposal process of legacy waste and the production of various by-products, such as RDF, bio-soil, and C&D waste bricks. Furthermore, the trainees toured the FSTP/STP plant in Ward 38, Bakerganj, where Executive Engineer Shri Siddharth Kumar guided them through the processing and treatment of faecal sludge and septage, managed by the Municipal Corporation.














5R (Refuse, Reduce, Reuse Recycle And Rot)



The 5R concept is a waste management framework aimed at reducing environmental impact through five key actions: Refuse, Reduce, Reuse, Recycle, and Rot. Refuse focuses on rejecting unnecessary or unsustainable products, such as single-use plastics or items with excessive packaging. Reduce encourages minimizing waste by consuming less and opting for long-lasting, high-quality products. Reuse involves finding new purposes for items, like repurposing containers or repairing goods to extend their life. Recycle ensures materials like paper, plastic, and glass are processed into new products, reducing the need for raw resources. Finally, Rot refers to composting organic waste, turning food scraps and biodegradable materials into nutrient-rich compost, which helps reduce landfill waste and emissions. Together, these steps promote a more sustainable and resource-conscious lifestyle.









Home Composting Awareness

Under the Swachh Ward Competition, residents of the colony were educated on how to create organic compost at home using wet waste. They were guided on effectively managing wet waste independently, preparing compost, and utilizing it for plants and trees. It was explained that adding buttermilk or vinegar during the composting process helps eliminate unpleasant odour. Feedback from the residents revealed that those with plants found home composting highly beneficial and were enthusiastic about adopting the practice. Some residents had already started composting at home, setting an example for others.










